Destinations Day - 10th July 2024

Each year, when the majority of the school is at Sports Day, we take the opportunity to support our Year 12 students by having a day dedicated to destinations. Our aim is that in September, those who are wanting to put in applications to apprenticeships, university or employment feel ready to do so, and are prepared with the necessary information. Our hope is that the students will be organised with their applications and alleviate any pressure in Year 13.

All students are expected to attend and the day will be registered as a normal school day. However, there will not be any subject lessons and the students will spend the day with their Form Group attending a series of workshops and sessions throughout the day. We will have presenters from University of Sheffield and Inner Drive to deliver sessions to all students.

All students will start to complete a UCAS application form online and will be provided with some direction for their personal statement. This also applies to any student who does not want to apply to university this year or has decided to apply for an apprenticeship or employment. The UCAS application process is a useful exercise to provide students with the skills necessary to complete online forms for their future. Your child will be provided with a booklet, to keep, with full details on how to complete their UCAS application. They will be able to share this with you at home and it will also be available for viewing electronically on Satchel One. Please ask your child to bring a pen and some paper/notebook with them and we will provide them with a paper copy of their GCSE results.

For students who are looking to apply for Medicine, Dentistry, Veterinary and Oxbridge, we have arranged for them to sit a practice early entry test (ie. UCAT, ESAT, MAT, PAT etc) where they will self evaluate the solutions after sitting the test. These students have already been identified and have confirmed if they wish to sit this test.

Students need to be in registration for 9.20am. The day will end for students at 2.30pm. A schedule of the day is shown below.
