

 - You make UoS your firm choice and apply for accommodation no later than 28 July (2024)
 - You make UoS your insurance choice or accept through clearing and apply for accommodation no later than 31 August (2024)

Summer Schools (1-3 weeks, in europe)



Degree with Employment Experience (DDE)

- Optional work placement in third year of study
- One year work placement in the UK or overseas
- Transfer onto a DDE equivalent of your current course in year 1 or 2
- Opportunity to further develop your knowledge, skills and understanding within an employment context
- Develop transferable skills, commercial awareness and potentially even secure your entry onto the graduate career ladder

Student Finance Explained

- University students can receive two different loans from Student Finance Englandthe tuition fee loan and the maintenance loan.
- The tuition fee loan covers the tuition cost of going to university. This is currently set at £9250.
- The maintenance loan contributes to day to day living costs a student has whilst studying. E.g accommodation, food, transport etc



Student Finance Explained

- The maintenance loan is means tested based on the household income of the residence where the student lives.
- Student Finance England have a maintenance loan calculator that provides the best estimate of how much maintenance a student will receive.

How involved in the process should I be?

Access +

You may be eligible for additional support through **Access+** if:

- You live in an area with a low rate of participation in higher education
- You're a care leaver
- You're care experienced
- You're estranged from family
- You're a carer
- You're a forced migrant
- You have parenting responsibilities
- You're entitled to free school meals

- As an Access+ student, you'll be eligible for wraparound support:
- financial support; Funded Open Days, IT & Equipment Bursaries, Sheffield Bursary
- a dedicated team on hand to answer your questions about university
- help with study skills and revision
- A reduced grade offer equivalent to one grade below the standard A Level entry requirements e.g. if the formal entry requirements for your course are ABB and you meet the criteria, you'll receive an alternative offer of BBB.
