## GCSE Results Day Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2024

Dear students, parents and carers,

We would firstly like to congratulate all Year 11s on completing their examinations; they can now look forward to a long and well-deserved summer holiday!

GCSE results will be released to students on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August. Year 11 students will need to arrive in form groups to collect their results; timings for each form group are detailed in the table below. Year 9, 10, 12 and 13 students collecting GCSE results will need to arrive at 11.30. Students who are unable to collect their results will need to contact school in writing if they wish to nominate an individual to collect them on their behalf; nominated individuals will need to bring a form of photo identification to collect the results and arrive at the allocated time for the child they are representing. These letters must be brought to school before the end of the academic year. In addition, any students who are absent on Results Day and have intentions to enrol in our 6<sup>th</sup> Form must inform the 6<sup>th</sup> Form team before the end of term. Please be aware school emails are not routinely checked over the school holidays and therefore contacting school via email during this time will not guarantee receipt of your communication. Please also note that <u>all results</u> will be sent out via email to the student's school email account at 12.30pm on Results Day.

Students collecting results in person will be asked to line up outside the main entrance at their allocated time. Members of the school team will be on hand to greet students and families as they arrive. Results will be handed out in the school dining room and students will be directed to the appropriate desk for collection. Members of the Leadership Team, 6<sup>th</sup> Form team and our Careers Adviser will be in school to offer support and guidance to any students who wish to talk through their next steps and options. Once results documents have been collected students will then move into the School Hall to exit, confirm their 6<sup>th</sup> form place or speak to a member of staff for further support. The 6<sup>th</sup> form team will meet with <u>all</u> prospective students to confirm places and courses.

Each examination board offers post results services; these include reviews of marking and access to completed exam scripts. Some of these services incur a fee which will be payable on ParentPay or via barcode letter in advance of the request being submitted by school. At this time the precise fees have not been published by the boards; these will be confirmed on Results Day. Please be aware we cannot guarantee teaching colleagues will be present on Results Day and therefore we may not be able to provide subject specific support for reviews of marking. Nevertheless, our exams team will be able to provide support for anyone wishing to pursue this route.

If any families have any items of school uniform in good condition which they will no longer need please do leave any items with us on Results Day as they will be added to our uniform supplies.

We look forward to seeing our Year IIs again on August 22<sup>nd</sup> as they begin the next stage in their exciting lives. In the meantime, we wish all students and families a wonderful holiday.
