Studying Four

We encourage all students to study four subjects. However, there is an additional entry requirement based on Attainment 8 (A8) for studying Sciences (Physics, Biology and Chemistry) and Maths:

To study all 3 Sciences and Maths, you need an A8 of 70 (equivalent to all As)

To study 3 Sciences or 2 Sciences and Maths, you need an A8 of 64 (a mixture of As and Bs)

To study 2 Sciences or 1 Science and Maths, you need an A8 of 55 (equivalent to all Bs)

Please note, on application, we will calculate your A8 and contact you should a query arise. Please see 'Making a Successful Application' for further clarification.

Can I chose five?

Because we work on four timetabling blocks, it is not structurally possible to study more than four subjects without missing significant amounts of teaching, usually in two subjects. We would not recommend this.

What if not enough people opt to do a subject?

If there are too few student choices to make a subject viable, we reserve the right to withdraw the subject and we will come back to you to ask you to make an alternative choice.

*Further Maths needs to be studied in **both** of these blocks.
